FDU Press celebrates 50th anniversary & relocates to Vancouver Campus

Madison, NJ & Vancouver, BC (June 26, 2017) – As it celebrates its 50th Anniversary, Fairleigh Dickinson University Press will relocate operations from Madison, NJ, to Vancouver, BC, the newest of FDU’s four campuses.

FDU Press has held editorial offices in Madison, New Jersey, since 1967 with Professor Harry Keyishian as Director since 1977. On July 1, 2017, the Press’s editorial office will begin relocating to Vancouver, British Columbia. James Gifford will assume the position of Director. The existing Editorial Committee and Advisory Board will continue its role in the review and selection of manuscripts for publication. Departing Director Harry Keyishian will remain a member of the editorial committee. The Editorial Committee and Advisory Board will continue to reflect the diversity and expertise of FDU’s four campuses – the Florham and Metropolitan campuses in New Jersey, the Vancouver Campus in British Columbia, and Wroxton College in Oxfordshire – while growing to reflect FDU’s global mission.

FDU Press operates through a co-publishing partnership with Rowman & Littlefield, Inc., which supplies editorial, production, and marketing services worldwide, as well as our annual catalog of publications. Manuscripts submitted to FDU Press are selected for publication solely on the basis of their contributions to scholarship and understanding, and all projects are subject to both internal review and evaluation by external specialist scholars. All publication decisions are made by an independent Editorial Committee composed of FDU faculty and an Advisory Board of scholars from around the world.
